Included in this definition are students with learning disabilities which refer to a number of disorders that affect the acquisition, organization, retention, understanding or use of verbal or nonverbal information.

  - score 5% higher than the province on average PAT grade.
  - achieve the highest marks of all special education programs in the province.

  - have 20% of its students achieve the Standard of Excellence.
  - score 5% higher than the province on average diploma examination grade.
  - achieve a discrepancy of less than 10% between the diploma examination mark and the school-awarded mark.
